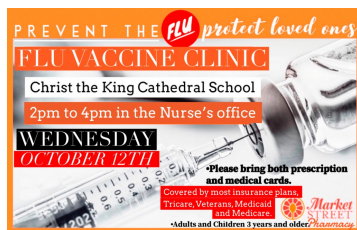

- All parents are asked to work at least one shift during the Fall Festival. This allows all families to enjoy the Festival with their children and our school community and spreads the work out among everyone. - Donations needed: Elementary students are asked to donate candy for game booth prizes. 6th & 10th grade students are asked to bring a 24-pack of water; 7th and 9th grade bring a 12-pack of soft drinks; 11th and 12th grades bring a 12-pack of sports drinks. *Please do not bring the drinks until the week of the Fall Festival due to lack of storage space.* Donations may be counted toward required volunteer time for the school year*!
- Parents are also asked to donate to your student's class basket for the silent auction as well as donations for the Cactus Walk. If you have not heard from your child's class room parents about donating to your class basket, please reach out to your student's teacher.

*Volunteer hours for donations can be entered following school guidelines: for each \$15 worth of goods donated, family can receive a 1-hour credit. Donated items and monetary donations can be used to cover up to half of your required hours. The remaining half should be fulfilled with volunteering your time which the Fall Festival is a perfect opportunity to serve some of those hours!

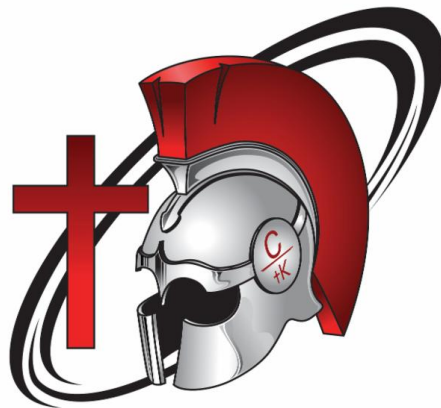
