

Christ the King Diocesan Schools Foundation 2025-2026 Scholarships Application

For almost 40 years, parents and CTK supporters have shown their generosity to the school by donating to the CTK Diocesan Schools Foundation's various endowment funds. The endowed scholarship program has continued to grow and now includes 28 named endowment funds that will provide over \$60,000 in scholarship funds ranging from \$250 to full tuition for one (1) school year for the 2025-26 school year. Some scholarships are awarded based on financial need though others are awarded based on other requirements such as grade level, academic success, student involvement, etc. Applicant's attendance and behavior records as well as family's school involvement can be taken into consideration during the selection process.

Christ the King Diocesan Schools Foundation scholarships are available to <u>current CTK</u> <u>Schools students who are pre-enrolled for Kindergarten – 12th grades</u> at CTK Schools for the 2025-2026 school year. All scholarship funds are paid directly to the schools on behalf of the recipient for tuition assistance.

Please fill out an application for <u>each</u> student to be considered for scholarship awards. Based on application responses, the CTK Diocesan Schools Foundation Scholarship Committee will determine for which scholarships an applicant is eligible. Complete scholarship applications and required documents should be submitted to the school office for consideration no later than Wednesday, April 30, 2025. Applications and documents can also be scanned and emailed to Mrs. Duran at <u>cduran@ctkschoolslbk.org</u> no later than Wednesday, April 30, 2025. Scholarship recipients will be announced no later than May 23, 2025.
